



PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The City of Delray Beach was awarded a federally funded grant from the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) under its Local Initiatives Program for the Old Germantown Road Complete Streets Project.

The grant will partially fund approximately 40% of construction and the remaining 60% will be funded by the City.

The project aims to improve multi-modal mobility, enhance pedestrian safety, provide accessible facilities that comply with the American Disability Act (ADA), introduce pedestrian lighting, and rehabilitate existing pavement.



PROJECT LOCATION




PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS


The following improvements will support the City of Delray Beach's Complete Streets Policy (adopted in 2016):

- Provide multiuse paths on both sides of Old Germantown Road.
 (A multiuse path is an off-street path to be used by pedestrians and cyclists)
- Improve ADA accessibility and install ADA compliant crosswalks.
- Preserve or restore existing pavement via milling and resurfacing, deep milling or full depth reclamation, as needed.
- Install pedestrian-scale lighting on both sides of the street.
- Install a few new and/or relocated trees between the roadway and multiuse paths.

TYPICAL ROADWAY SECTION - EXISTING




TYPICAL ROADWAY SECTION - PROPOSED DESIGN



PROJECT DESIGN

- This image only depicts the segment across the bridge along Old Germantown Road.
- No construction will occur on the bridge.
- The only work that will occur is restriping.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Maintenance of Traffic (MOT):

- At least one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Flaggers may be utilized for alternating one-way traffic.

Access:

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

Public Outreach:

- Project website will be kept up to date with information on construction activities being performed and anticipated traffic impacts.
- City will maintain a log of resident concerns and resolutions.
